**Annual roof maintenance** is crucial because it helps prevent costly damage, extends the lifespan of your roof, and protects your home from leaks, mold, and structural issues. Small problems like missing shingles, clogged gutters, or worn flashing can escalate into major repairs if ignored, leading to water damage, higher energy bills, and even pest infestations. By inspecting your roof at least **two times a year**, you catch minor issues early, avoid emergency repairs, and ensure your home stays safe, energy-efficient, and structurally sound.
